Code of Conduct

Summary:

All Sun City Dance Company members are expected to act in a dignified and respectable manner at all times. Behavior that could reflect negatively on the Dance Company or the teachers will be subject to review by the Director and the Board of Directors.

Expectations:

- 1. Dancers are expected to be on time, dressed, on the floor, and ready to dance when class starts.
- 2. If a dancer is unable to attend class, the teacher or class representative should be notified prior to the start of class.
- 3. Insubordination or disrespect toward any teacher or disruption of a class are grounds for dismissal from the Dance Company.
- 4. No alcohol before any classes or performances.
- 5. Observe all no smoking regulations.
- 6. Follow all rules regarding performances including dressing room etiquette and backstage behavior.
- 7. Any problems that cannot be taken to the teacher should be first brought to the class representative who will either approach the teacher or take the issue to the Director or the Board of Directors.
- 8. Payment each month is due in a timely manner without need for reminders. If desired, pre-payment can be accepted for future months.
- 9. During class:
 - a. Do not chew gum.
 - b. Background noise during class makes it difficult to hear the teacher and is distracting. Converse with other members before or after class, not during. c. Do not give unsolicited instruction to fellow members. Leave all teaching to the instructor.
 - d. If you have questions regarding steps, direct them to the teacher.
 - e. Do not wear perfume or scented lotions/deodorant to class.
 - f. Be aware of personal hygiene. Bathe and regularly wash clothing. Wear deodorant.
 - g. Wear clothing that is comfortable, safe, and appropriate. This would include leggings, dance pants, dance skirts, and tights. Teachers recommend not wearing jeans, wide-legged pants, or pants that are too long and may be a tripping hazard.
 - h. Tap shoes should not be double or jingle taps.
